be changed by the moderator when sent to the participants, in order to better suit the purposes of the discussion.

- If you wish to reply to another participant's contribution, you are required to state the exact title of the contribution to which you refer.
- The Forum will remain open until 13 April 2007. After the closure of the Forum, and depending on the quality and quantity of the contributions, the possibility of some kind of publication of the Forum's outcome will be considered.
