The course starts with a demonstration of what it takes in the "wet-lab" to generate raw data and filter out reliable marker information which is diagnostic for the entire genome. The theory behind exploiting linkage disequilibrium will be explained and "toy-data" sets of limited sizes will be used to calculate genomic relationships from raw data and estimate genomic breeding values. Their use to enhance power and efficacy of selecting the best sires will be demonstrated and discussed by the practitioner from the VIT Verden (Germany).

All scientists presenting the different topics are experts with long standing records of research in the field. The number of participants is limited to 15 to leave enough time for individual discussions and answering particular questions.

Dummerstorf is located close to the city of Rostock. A shuttle service will be provided to bring the delegates from the Rostock railway station to the venue and also to the respective hotel etc. Rostock may easily be reached from Hamburg airport via train.
